# 2021 SUMMIT REACH BY THE NUMBERS

#### 700,000

Our 5 Daily Speaker Sessions surpassed 700,000 total views, with over 600,000 unique views, as of February 28, 2021.

#### 47

Within the US, registrants represented 47 out of 50 states, participating from all except Wyoming, South Dakota, and West Virginia.

#### 705

705 students attended the 50 fair booths participating in our Career & Special Opportunities Fair, which showcased the extensive research, career, travel, internship, and study abroad opportunities that Israel has to offer.

#### 531

Students attended the Summit from 531 universities. The largest population from a university was 454 students registered from the University of Pennsylvania, followed by 247 students from Harvard University.

#### 136

The Israel Summit 2021 was planned by a team of 136 students from 56 universities.

#### 89

The Summit had registrants representing 89 countries, with roughly 1/3 of attendees from outside the United States. Top participating countries include Mexico, Italy, South America, Israel, Ethiopia, and Sudan.
